Total Number of Residents being treated with confirmed COVID+ as of today: Zero

Reason for notification:

- New COVID+ resident or staff
 3 or more residents or staff with new respiratory symptoms within 72 hours
 Weekly notice

Mitigation strategies: We will continue to update policies, procedures and educate staff per CDC guidelines. We have decided to designate a certain unit within the facility as an observation unit until further notice. At this time, we have adequate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). We will continue to conduct rounds to assure PPE is used properly and we will continue to follow the “No Visitor” guidelines when appropriate. We will also continue to monitor anyone who enters the facility for known signs and symptoms of the COVID-19 virus and will not allow anyone with symptoms to enter the facility. Testing for COVID-19 of staff and residents is being done as necessary and/or required.

Whenever capacity provides the ability, all residents who are confirmed to have COVID-19 will be transferred out of the facility.

¹ Per CMS guidelines, our facility is required to notify residents, families and resident representatives of the presence of confirmed new COVID-19 cases in our facility and/or when 3 or more staff/residents develop new respiratory symptoms within 72 hours of one another no later than 5pm the following day. Additionally, we are required to provide a weekly update of facility activities related to COVID-19 including mitigation strategies.
